



## DTO Safety Policy Statement

Safety is the first priority in all our activities. We are committed to implementing, developing and improving strategies and processes to ensure that all our activities uphold the highest level of safety performance and meet national and international standards.

Our commitment is to:

- a. Develop and embed a safety culture in all our training activities that recognizes the importance and value of effective aviation safety and acknowledges at all times that safety is paramount;
- b. Clearly define for all members their accountabilities for the development and delivery of aviation safety performance;
- c. Minimize the risk associated with training operations to a point that is as low as reasonably practicable/achievable;
- d. Actively develop and improve our safety processes;
- e. Comply with and, wherever possible, exceed legislative and regulatory requirements and standards;
- f. Ensure that all members are provided with adequate and appropriate aviation safety information and training, and are only allocated tasks commensurate with their skills;
- g. Conduct annual internal safety reviews and ensure that relevant action is taken if needed.
